IRISH

BUSHMILLS 10 (40%)

Banana, honey, milk chocolate, apples, pears, and buttery shortbread.

JAMESON GOLD RESERVE (40%)

Vanilla toasted oak aroma, balanced with a pleasant peppery finish.

SCOTCH

SPEYSIDE

Speyside is a region in the northeast side of Scotland, so called as the region surrounds the river Spey, and is home to the highest concentration of distilleries in all of Scotland. The characteristics of these whiskeys are usually light and fruity, soft and delicate; the distilleries around here pride themselves in producing easy-drinking, smooth whiskeys and rarely burn peat to flavour their spirit. These are perfect for people that are just getting into whisky or for people that don't want something too aggressive.

GLENFIDDICH 12 (40%)

Apples, pears, flowers. Generally soft and fruity.

GLENLIVET 12 (40%)

Pears, apple pie, vanilla, exotic fruits. Tastes like pear drops!

SINGLETON 12 (40%)

Pastry and fruit cake. Butter, oranges, dried fruit. Subtle and fruity.

LOWLAND

There are only a very small amount of whiskeys made in the lowlands of Scotland. These whiskeys are very soft, quite grassy and mellow. They make for very easy drinking and this is no accident. During the industrial revolution there was a large influx of Irish immigrants into Scotland, mainly to help with the construction of its industrial capitals: Glasgow and partly Edinburgh. After time, the Irish got sick of the harsh Scottish whiskeys, missing their smooth, triple distilled spirit. To cater for this demand, lowland whisky began to be the softest and easiest going of all Scottish malt whisky – perfect for people fresh to drinking whisky.

GLENKINCHIE 12 (43%)

Strawberries and grass, strawberry laces, strawberry jam, apples, and soft spice.

ISLANDS

Whisky from the Scottish isles is still quite difficult to pinpoint; however the overriding feeling with this area is marine. The Scottish islands are exclusively on the west coast of the country: running from Arran in the south west of the country, past Islay and right up to the Orkney Islands far up north. Island whiskeys are quite often peated to a high level; they are quite often smoky and medicinal but almost always salty. Island whiskeys are almost like baby Islays – they share many of the characteristics but not usually as aggressive and big as their neighbour.

JURA ORIGIN (40%)

Orange peel and confected fruits, marmalade, jam, sugary fruit jellies. Sweet, soft and delicate.

TALISKER 10 (45.8%)

Smoked BBQ on the beach, seaweed, salt, brine, sea spray, sweet wood smoke and white pepper.

SCOTCH

BLENDED

It is a common misconception that blended Scotch is not very good, to put it politely.

There certainly are quite a few that give blended Scotch a bad name, however there are plenty of excellent blended Scotch Whiskies out there. Single malts are essentially a selection of casks from one single distillery, whereas blends are a combination of whiskies from different distilleries with some single grain whisky thrown into the mix. Blends are usually smoother, softer, easier to drink, and often a bit sweeter because of that grain whisky. Give them a chance!

CHIVAS REGAL 12 (40%)

Wood shavings and custard creams, crunchy nut cereal, dried bananas, and light spice.

JOHNNIE WALKER BLUE (40%)

Rich, smoky, and velvety smooth. Breaking waves of powerful flavours.

HAIG CLUB (40%)

Apple, shortbread and dried grass. Toffee, vanilla, oak and nougat. Accessible spice and toffee.

JOHNNIE WALKER GOLD (40%)

Soft cooked fruits, slightly floral, slight toffee, good bit of fruit cake, velvety. A great all rounder.

Sweet spice, subtle smoke, fudge and treacle. Festive spice.

A luxuriously rich, fruity and smooth blend.

ISLAY

Islay is famous for producing the biggest flavoured whiskies in Scotland. At one stage, to dry out the malted barley that whisky is made of, all distilleries would burn rotting vegetation or 'peat'. As the industrial revolution swept from east coast to west, distilleries did this less and less; relying on hot air instead. Islay was the exception, keeping this process which gives their distinct style; medicinal, smoky, earthy and 'peaty' flavours.

Whisky-making region is often seen like Marmite; you either love it or you hate it! As Islay is only a small island off the west coast of the country, the whisky they produce is often quite nautical in style, giving a salt and pepper vibe to it.

BOWMORE 12 (40%)

Flowers, fruit, smoke, potpourri, perfume and honey. Fresh, hint of peat smoke. Not for the faint-hearted.

LAPHROAIG 10 (40%)

Ash, cigarette smoke and bit fishy, surprisingly sweet, seaweed, salty, bandages, TCP & hospitals, surf and turf, loads of seaside.

SCOTCH

HIGHLANDS

This whisky producing region is expansive. It historically has no strict style as it covers such a vast amount of land and many distilleries come under its blanket. At a push, you could say that highland whiskies are often quite fruity but with some tastes of toffee and fudge, sometimes smoke and occasional spice. Highland whisky falls neatly between Speyside and Islay in style – not overpowering but still often big in style. This region is possibly best for those trying to build up to the Islay and Island whiskies.

DALMORE 12 (40%)

Darker flavours like nuts and coffee, sweet fruits, vanilla and subtle dried fruits, tangerines.

DALWHINNIE 15 (43%)

Cut grass, sweet honey and heather. Faintest smoke but full of sweet flavours.

Rich fruit cake, apricot jam, cinnamon, dried fruits and soft orchard fruits.

GLENMORANGIE ORIGINAL (40%)

Tangerines, oranges, nectarines, faint coffee, fruit salad. Soft and fruity.

JAPANESE

Japanese whiskies heritage comes from Scottish whisky and much the same it varies from distillery to distillery. The first Japanese whisky producers would even import their malt from Scotland and the ways in which the whiskies are produced uphold Scottish tradition. Each Japanese distillery has quite a unique style and as they have been producing whisky for almost 100 years, they've developed a massive range and have about 10 working distilleries producing everything from light almost speyside like tipples, to big bold smoky drams.

NIKKA ALL MALT (40%)

Flowers, toffee, smallest notes of smoke. Creamy, brown sugar. Slight dried fruit.

NIKKA COFFEY MALT (45%)

Candied lemon, rich spicy cake, toffee, marzipan, rich-textured, cinnamon, clove, citrus. Harmonious blend of dense spices, rich oak and citrus peels.
